For discount airfare and car rental reservations, please call 800-457-7351 and advise the agent you are with the American Jail Association. Discounts are available on Delta, US Airways, Continental, and Northwest airlines serving the Portland International Airport. **International Tours** will waive administrative fees for AJA conference attendees. Please reference file number AJA2010. You may also fax your travel request to 610-925-3923.

In addition, **International Tours** is pleased to offer 10% off the lowest applicable published fares for tickets purchased 60 days in advance. ## Airport Transportation

The Metropolitan Area Express (**MAX**) light rail system runs from the Portland International Airport (PDX) to stations near (within 5 minutes walking distance) the Hilton Portland & Executive Tower and the Doubletree Hotel Portland—Lloyd Center hotels. Fares are under \$5. Airport shuttle ser-

vice directly to the hotels is also available from **Blue Star Shuttle** for \$14, or \$24 roundtrip. (Prices listed are 2009 rates.) You will find airport shuttles and the MAX (Red Line) train on the baggage claim level. Hotels are 20–35 minutes from the airport by shuttle; 30–45 minutes by MAX.

## Lodging

The Hilton Portland & Executive Tower is the conference headquarters hotel. Both the Hilton Portland & Executive Tower and the Doubletree Hotel Portland—Lloyd Center hotels are located within the MAX's **Fareless Square** (see Attractions). The MAX Red Line provides service from the Hilton to the Oregon Convention Center, where attendee/exhibitor registration, Sunday through Wednesday workshops, and the Jail Expo will take place. **Both hotels are 100% non-smoking.**
