The Denver Sheriff Department is seeking candidates for the position of correctional institution food manager. This position manages high-volume food service operations, including kitchen safety and security for inmate helpers and staff at the Denver County Jail and the Downtown Detention Center.

The correctional institution food manager position is responsible for the oversight of all food operations at the Denver County Jail and the Downtown Detention Center. This position supervises three institution food steward supervisors and 19 institutional food stewards who are responsible for high-volume food preparation and food service work. In 2010, the Food Services staff served approximately 2,000,000 inmate meals. As such, this position is critical for ensuring that all inmates receive meals and for ensuring that the department meets and maintains the standards of food service for correctional care according to the American Correctional Association and National Commission on Correctional Health Care.

Our facilities are 24/7 operational environments, so applicants must be willing to work evenings, holidays and weekends. Salary is \$43,887.00-\$69,993.00 annually. The position is open until filled.
